

PARTICIPATIONS

According to the PZOS regulations, competitors taking part in CTZ competitions who want to participate in sports competitions organized by PZOS (competition for ranking points) are obliged to have a current PZOS license. However, the lack of a license does not exclude competitors from sports competition during the Bukowa Cup, the competition is open to everyone.

Everyone is required to have valid medical examinations. Persons taking part in the Bukowa Cup competition who do not have valid medical examinations are obliged to present a declaration of participation at the Competition Center at their own risk.

TERREINS AND MAPS

STAGE 1 - long (1.05.2024 - Wednesday)

A typical moraine with a very good to very difficult course and a well-developed road network. The forest is heavily used for economic purposes.

Map: scale 1: $10\,000$, for the K/M60 and older categories 1: $7\,500$, contour lines every 5m, ISOM 2017, A3-A4 format depending on the category, updated in spring 2023.







STAGE 2 - sprint (1.05.2024 - Thursday)

The area of a Polish housing estate with both single-staircase and multi-staircase blocks, with a fragment of a single-family house estate. Flat terrain. There is normal car traffic on the premises.

Map: scale 1: 4 000 and 1: 3 000 for the K/M60 and older categories, contour lines every 2m, ISSprOM 2019-2, A4 format, March 2024.

The area has never been used for Orienteering competitions.







STAGE 3 - middle, STAGE 4 - night (2.05.2024 - Friday)

The first part of the area is a typical moraine, with a very good to very difficult traversability with a well-developed road network, in the second part there is a smaller elevation gain with elements of micro-relief and lush vegetation. The forest is heavily used for economic purposes.

Map: scale 1: 10 000, for the K/M50 for the K/M60 and older categories 1: 7 500, contour lines every 5m, ISOM 2017, A4 format, updated in spring 2023.







STAGE 5 - middle, STAGE 6 - night (3.05.2024 - Saturday)

The first part is a typical moraine, with traversability ranging from very good to very difficult with a well-developed road network. The second part is a flat area that is a military training ground. It is characterized by a large number of holes, depressions, ditches and various military infrastructure facilities. Convenience ranges from very good to difficult. The forest is heavily used for economic purposes.

Map: scale 1 : 10 000, for the K/M50 for the K/M60 and older categories 1 : 7 500, contour lines every 5m, ISOM 2017, A4 format, updated in spring 2023.







STAGE 7 - middle (4.05.2024 - Saturday)

The area consists of two parts: moraine, with a very good to very difficult traversability with a well-developed road network. The second part is an area with many holes and a coniferous forest. Forest is heavily used for economic purposes.

Map: scale 1 : 10 000, for the K/M50 for the K/M60 and older categories 1 : 7 500, contour lines every 5m, ISOM 2017, A4 format, updated in autumn 2023.







STAGE 8 - long (5.05.2024 - Sunday)

A typical moraine, with traversability ranging from very good to very difficult, with a well-developed road network. The forest is heavily used for economic purposes.

Map: scale 1: 10 000, for the K/M65 for the K/M60 and older categories 1: 7 500, contour lines every 5m, ISOM 2017, A3-A4 format depending on the category, updated in spring 2023.







CONTROL POINTS

The SportIdent AIR+ contactless checkpoint confirmation system will be used during the competition.

It is possible to rent an SI chip from the Organizer. This should be indicated in the application.

Attention!! The validity of the application on a given date is determined by the payment of the entry fee to the organizer's account, and not by the fact of completing the application form.

SI AIR+ chip rental for the entire competition 50 PLN/pcs - limited quantity, first come first serve basis,

SI chip rental - older model for the entire competition 24 PLN/pcs.

Losing the SI chip - PLN 360/pcs.

Any changes, i.e. chip or category number **after April 16** or at the Competition Center – 10 PLN/change

Resignation from participation – In the event of resignation from the competition, after making the payment, the entry fee is non-refundable. It is not possible to transfer the entry fee to another competitor.

Competitors who did not show up at the start but registered are obliged to cover 50% of the entry fee.

ACCOMMODATION
